## **What is TechCrew?**

TechCrew offers students in grades 6-12 the opportunity to prepare, first-hand, for post-secondary education and the technology workforce through a series of extracurricular classroom learning and hands-on training.

## **How Does TechCrew Work?**

Students enrolled in TechCrew fix technological problems in the schools, under the supervision of the school's TechCrew coach. That's right – students actually learn to log issues for repair, make repairs to computers and equipment, answer staff questions and generally help to keep their school's fleet of computers and equipment in good working condition.

## **What Do Students Gain from TechCrew?**

In addition to hands-on training and experience in IT, TechCrew students also learn real-world business skills to help them prepare for post-secondary education and the workforce.
